Sealants Placed



69,942

Dental sealants are thin coatings applied to molar (back) teeth to prevent cavities. Generally for kids age 5-14, sealants reduce the risk of tooth decay by up to 80% for several years.

Fluoride Varnish Treatments



37,801



Fluoride varnish is a temporary gel applied to teeth to make them stronger and prevent decay. The treatment is proven to reduce cavities.

Number of Cleanings

36,068



Plaque removal and polish.



All children seen were referred to a dentist as part of good oral health practice. Children with urgent needs were provided help getting a dentist appointment.
