Starting July 1, 2020, a feature called Prevention Pays will be included in Delta Dental of South Dakota's fully insured dental plans with no additional premium cost.

Prevention Pays exempts diagnostic and preventive dental services from a plan's annual maximum benefit calculation. We're also adding periodontal maintenance cleanings to Prevention Pays to enhance benefits even more. On average, the changes extend an additional \$500 in coverage every year!

Oral health is an important part of overall health. Preventing tooth decay and gum disease is where it starts. Including our new enhanced Prevention Pays feature will help members get the dental care they need to stay healthy and productive.

Covered for preventive care.

Having Prevention Pays means members will be covered for procedures like exams, cleanings, x-rays, and periodontal maintenance cleanings even if they have reached their annual maximum benefit.

The Prevention Pays feature will be included in our fully insured dental plans starting July 1, 2020. Other plan design details still apply, like deductible, co-insurance, and frequency limits, if any. Self-insured plans are not automatically included.

No additional premium cost.

There is no additional premium cost to add Prevention Pays to existing plans, and we've frozen rates for plans renewed from May 2020 through April 2021 to provide rate stability.

Plans with our Health *through* Oral Wellness program include added preventive care benefits for members at high risk of tooth decay or gum disease. Adding Prevention Pays means members who unlock additional preventive care benefits will be covered for the services that help them get and stay healthy.
